**The information sheet provides information about which days and times and which conditions must be observed. In the interest of everyone involved to cooperate with each other!**

## Which places are?

### Maria-Theresien-Straße:

- ① North side in front of the Annasäule
- ② in front of the hospital church (not 18.00-19.00 due to the mass celebration)

### Old Town:

- ③ in front of the city tower
- ④ Crossing Kiebachgasse / Seilergasse
- ⑤ Franziskanerplatz

### Other squares:

- ⑥ Waltherpark
- ⑦ Rennweg meeting zone (Leopold fountain; not 20.00-21.00)
- ⑧ Wiltener Platzl (not on Saturday from 11.00-12.00, not on Sunday)

**ATTENTION:** If there is a construction site or a registered event or meeting is taking place at one of the above-mentioned locations, we cannot offer a replacement.

## When can music be played where?

February 1 to October 31

# What is required for me to be allowed to perform street music in Innsbruck?

Street music is an event subject to registration in accordance with the Tyrolean Events Act. The registration period is 7 days.

For the uncomplicated handling of the required official procedure, the City of Innsbruck offers a simplified online form for the registration of street music at: [www.innsbruck.gv.at/strassenmusik-formular](http://www.innsbruck.gv.at/strassenmusik-formular) or with QR code



You can receive the notification on the 2nd working day after the online registration from 10.00 a.m. at the **B** Bürgerservice of the City of Innsbruck, Maria-Theresien-Straße 18, ground floor of the City Hall, against payment of the administrative fee. As an alternative to the online application, an analog form can be filled out at the Citizens' Service and a copy of an official photo ID can be handed in. In this case, the decision can be issued after 4 working days at the earliest.

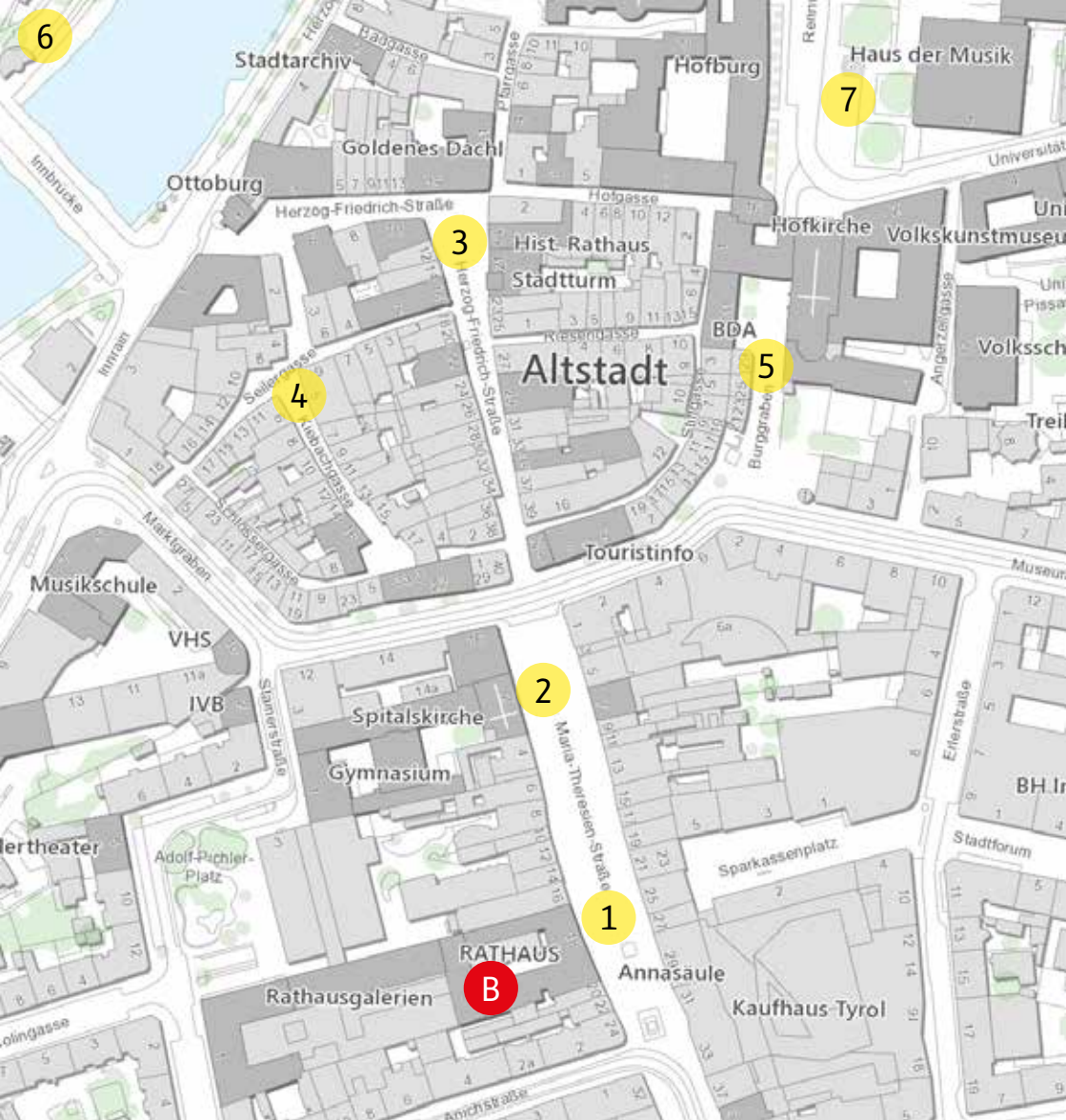
**ATTENTION:** The issued notification must be carried with you and presented to the authorities with a document proving your identity upon request.

## What should I bear in mind?

As some places are close to each other or other events are taking place nearby, music-making is only permitted with these instruments: string, woodwind and keyboard instruments, guiros, maracas, rattles

- Permission is not granted for making music with brass and percussion instruments (e.g. drum set, drums, timpani) and musical instruments that require a power supply for operation. (power supply, rechargeable battery, battery, etc.)
- Platforms and other structures are not permitted.
- A limited number of permits will be issued in the form of a notification for each day.

Battery-powered acoustic amplifiers are permitted at low volume (comparable to room volume) for background music. Any other use of acoustic amplifiers is not permitted! Inquiries and information at: [post.veranstaltungen@innsbruck.gv.at](mailto:post.veranstaltungen@innsbruck.gv.at)
