Open Call

Festival of Diversity – Democracy, Human Rights and Participation Saturday, 20 June 2026, 12 to 8 PM

The open call for active participation in the Festival of Diversity has started. The 2026 event places a clear focus on democracy, human rights and social participation. NGOs with a commitment to people with a migrant and refugee history, migrant associations and people who are committed to these issues are all invited. The Integration Office of the City of Innsbruck, the Tyrolean State Museums and the Integration Forum in cooperation with the Music Office are in charge of the organisational framework.

Low-threshold access, careful selection and fair pay for participants are priorities for the organisers. The festival at the Innsbruck Folk Art Museum is intended to showcase living diversity in the city. At the same time, it sends out a clear signal that democracy, human rights and participation are immutable and fundamental values of a peaceful society.

The aim is to create a varied and diverse program. Booths and a long table will be set up in the museum's inner courtyard for this purpose. The rooms on the second floor of the museum are again be open for workshops or smaller, more intimate programmes. Ideas for events that incorporate the exhibitions and museum items are also welcome.

We look forward to receiving a wide range of proposals and submissions. The selection will be made based on the content and available resources. The City of Innsbruck will provide an expense allowance for participation and cover any material costs incurred.
