### **Course details:**

In memoriam of the 450th anniversary of the death of Emperor Maximilian I., the state capital of Innsbruck in 1969 organised and sponsored the “Paul Hofhaimer Prize” for interpreters of compositions for organ by early composers.

**In an endeavor to enhance and enrich the launch of ‘Maximilian Year’ 2019, a Paul Hofhaimer Academy will be initiated for the first time in 2018.**

The Paul Hofhaimer Organ Academy is a seminar for interpreters of early music designed for organ players who desire to expand their knowledge and experience of historic organs of the city of Innsbruck.

The academy will take place from Wednesday, 29 August until Saturday, 1 September in Innsbruck.

All course participants will be informed about admittance to the Academy within one week of the registration deadline.

Maximum 10 participants will be permitted to take part;

Age limit: date of birth in 1987 or thereafter;

With confirmation of registration, all participants will receive a request for payment of the course fee of € 100,--.

Your registration becomes valid as soon as the fee is received by the course organisation. The fee is not refundable in case of non-participation.

Please note: The required works for the “19<sup>th</sup> Organ Competition for the Paul Hofhaimer Prize of the state capital of Innsbruck from 30 August until 5 September 2019” are not dealt with during the Organ Academy.
